Products AND Practices Are Key to Keeping Flu at Bay

Pay special attention to high-touch surfaces such as; doorknobs & push plates, light switches, desk tops, restroom fixtures, telephones, elevator buttons, etc.
- Wash linens (such as bed sheets, table linens, and towels) by using laundry sanitizers and soap, and wash hands immediately after handling dirty laundry.
- Do not reuse eating utensils without cleaning in a dishwasher using detergent first.
